

137(XII) Technical co-operation activities and  
technical assistance projects

The Economic Commission for Western Asia.

Recognizing the importance of technical co-operation activities and technical assistance projects for the development of the countries of the region,

Noting with appreciation the activities carried out by the secretariat in that field, as reviewed in document E/ECWA/XII/5/Add.1/Part II,

Desirous of strengthening the relevant programme submitted in document E/ECWA/XII/CP/6/Add.1,

1. Requests the Executive Secretary to reformulate the programme in such a way as to increase the programme elements in accordance with the needs of member countries;

2. Further requests the Executive Secretary to specify in the programme the types of advisory services to be provided, the fields in which they are to be provided, and the titles and fields of the projects that are to be financed in future from extrabudgetary resources;

3. Calls upon the Executive Secretary to prepare a preliminary outline of the main features of the next programme, as well as its estimated financial resources, and to submit that outline to the Commission at its thirteenth session.
