## 23 Objectives

23 Objectives that offer a roadmap for achieving safe, orderly, and regular migration

## Implementation

Implementation of the GCM requires concerted efforts at global, regional, national and local levels, including a coherent United Nations system

## Follow up & review

Countries committed to conducting regular follow up and review of the progress made at local, national, regional and global levels in implementing the GCM
