

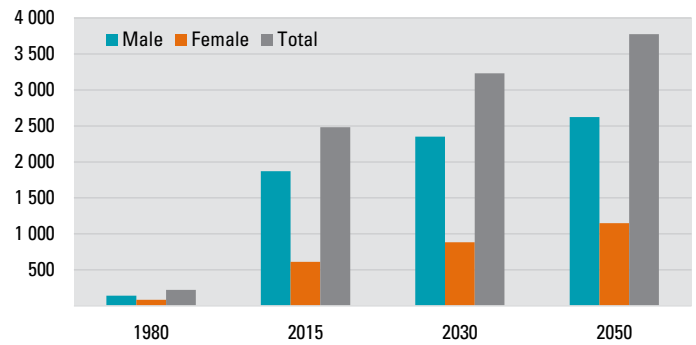

### Population size (thousands)



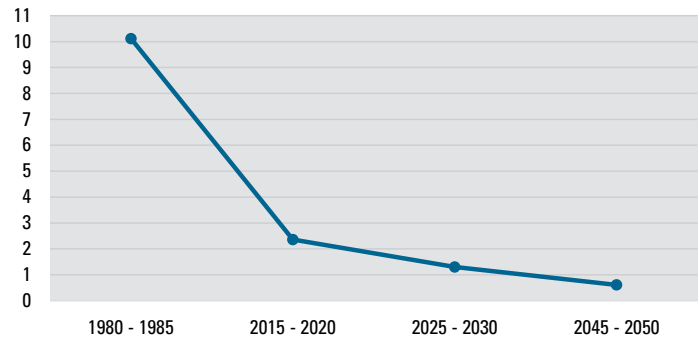

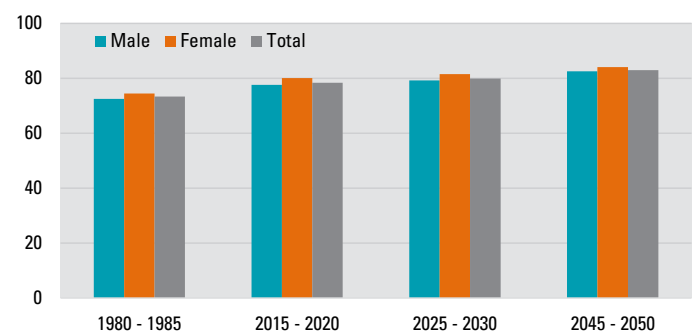

### Life expectancy at birth (years)



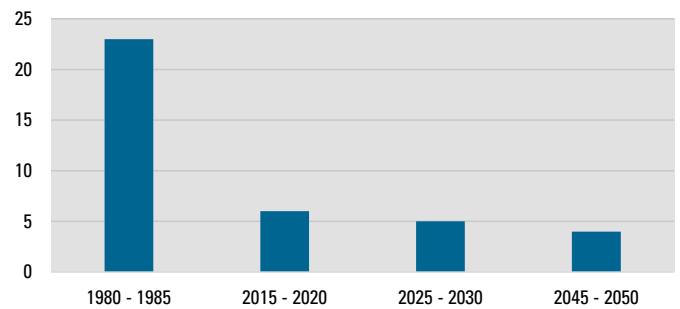

### Infant mortality rate (infant deaths per 1 000 live births)



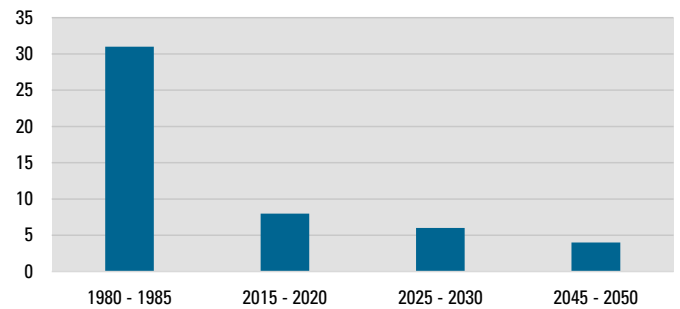

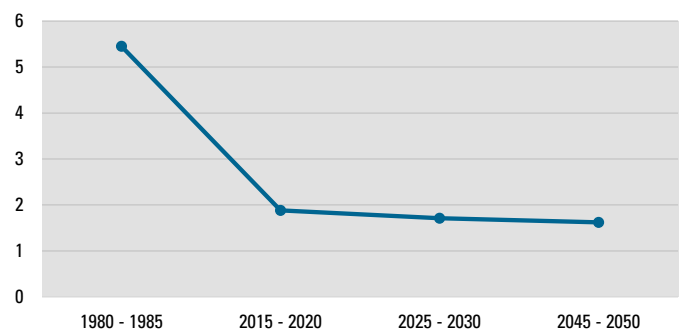

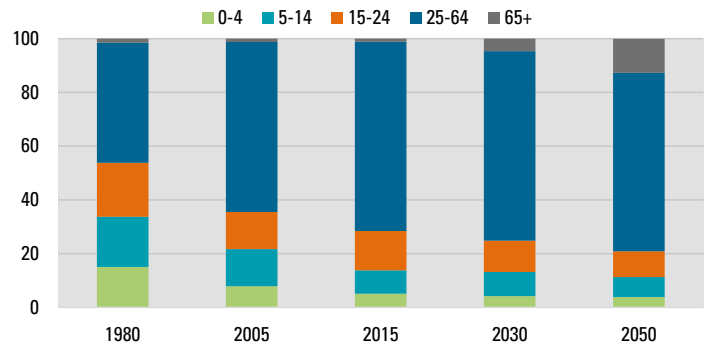

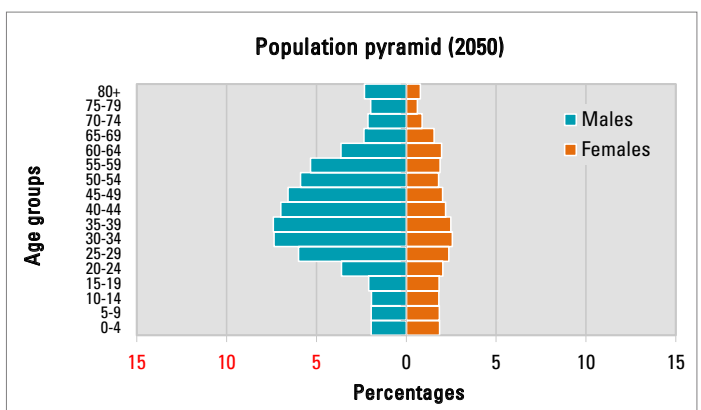

### Population pyramid



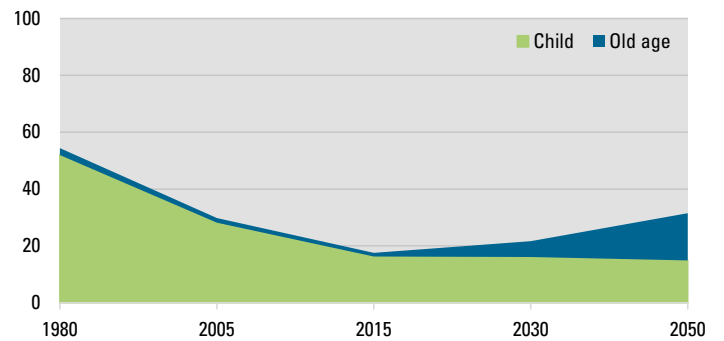

The demographic change in Qatar is not clear due to the distorted age structure resulting from the sizeable labour migration flow into the country. This is the case in most oil-producing countries.

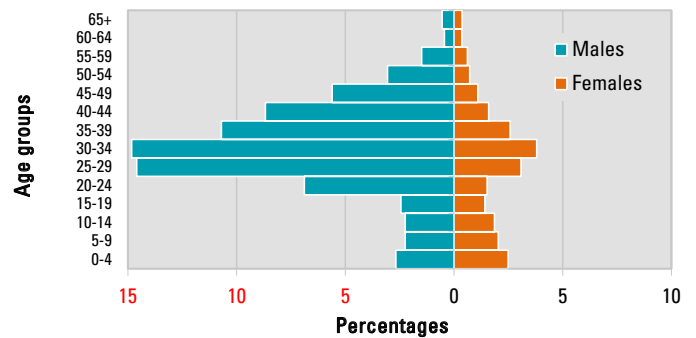

### Urban population by age and sex, 2015



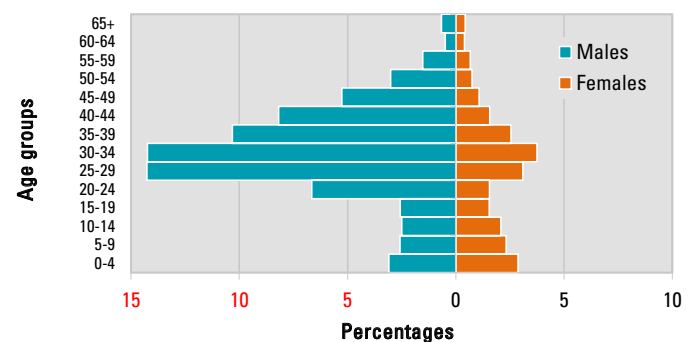

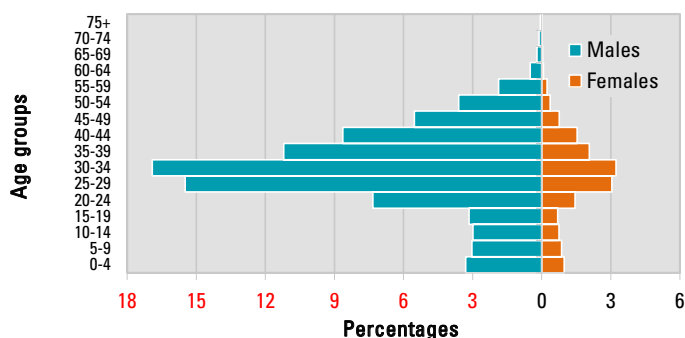
