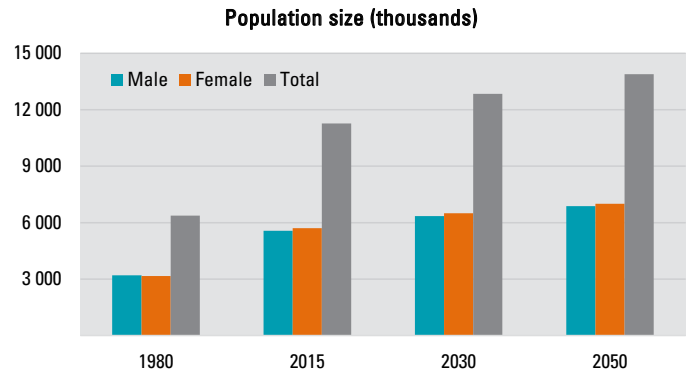

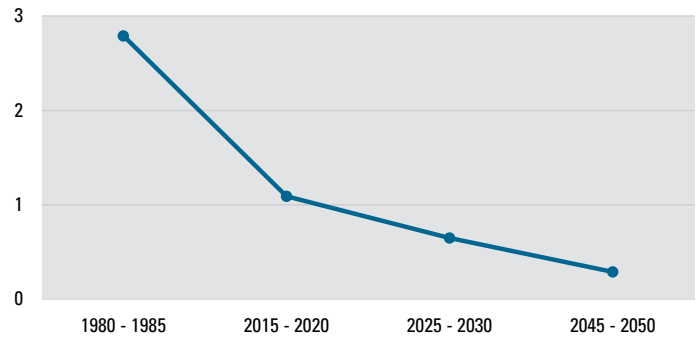

Average annual rate of population change (percentage)



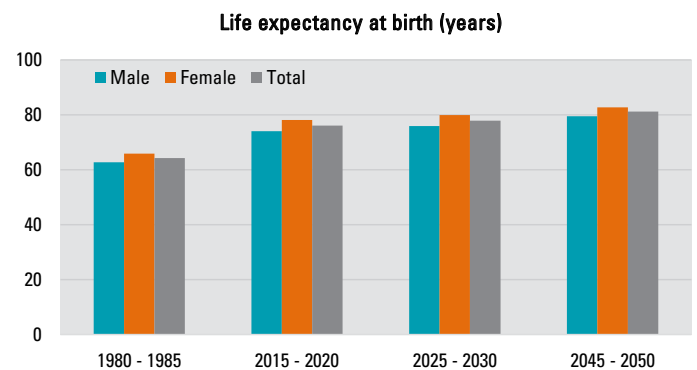

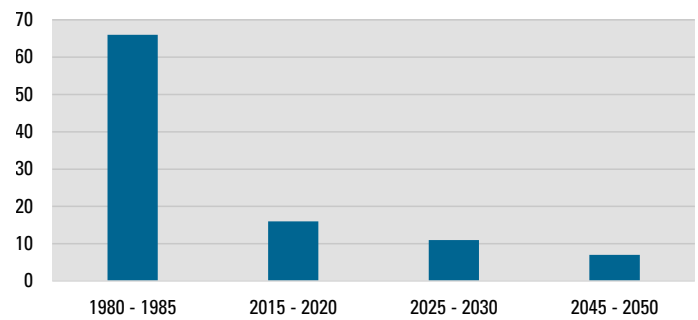

Infant mortality rate (infant deaths per 1 000 live births)



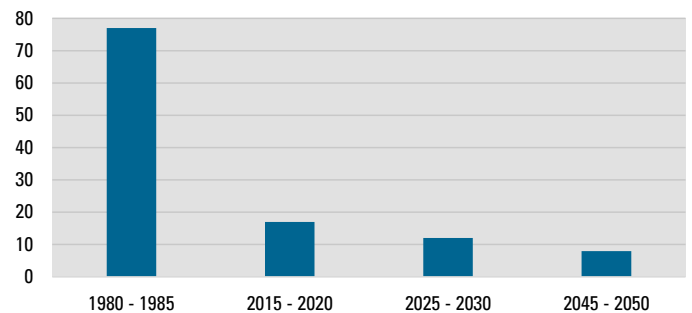

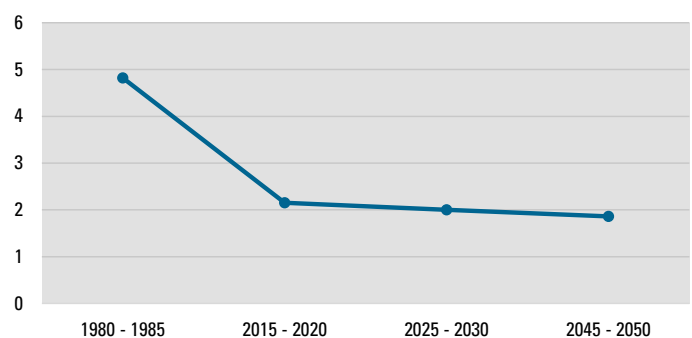

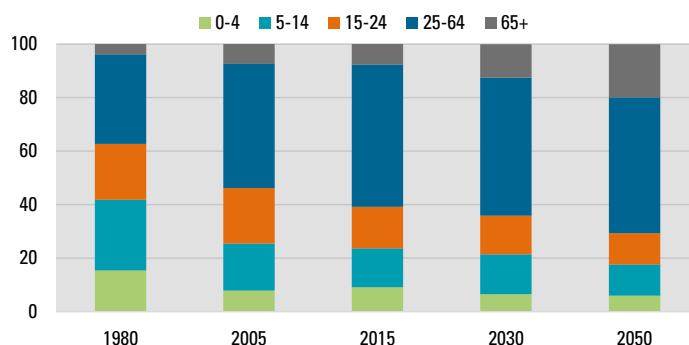

Population pyramid



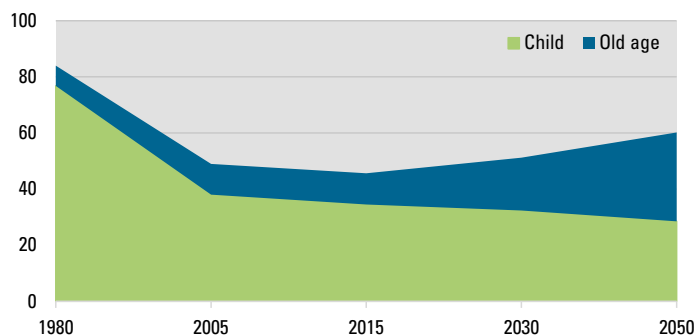

Dependency ratio (percentage)



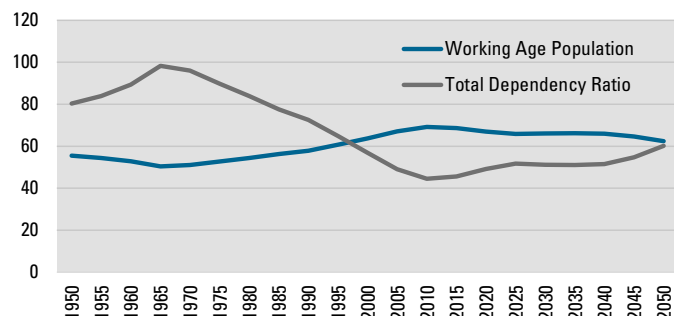

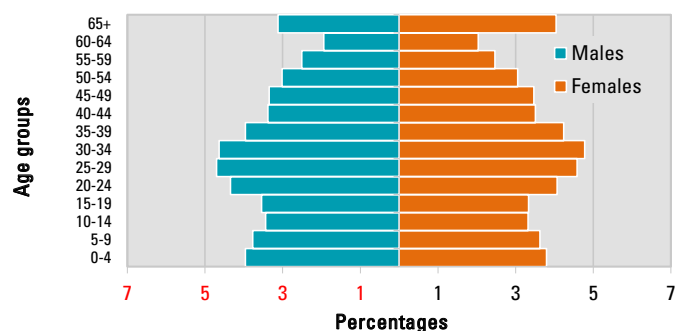

Urban population by age and sex, 2015



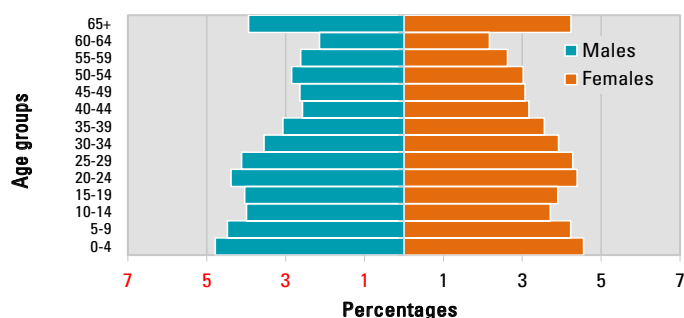

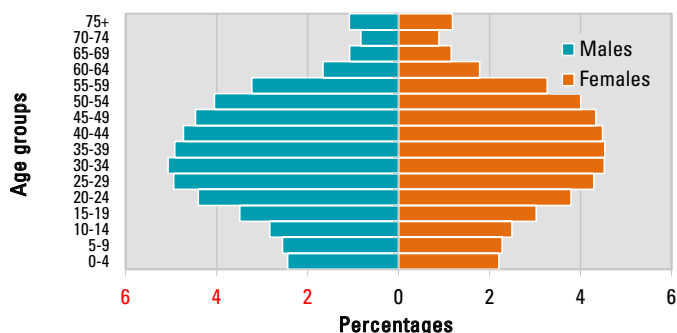
